## **Women's Issues**

FAWL supports ratification of the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the United States relating to equal rights for men and women.

FAWL supports the "Mary B. Hooks Act," which includes lymph node dissections under provisions prescribing length of hospital stay relating to mastectomies & outpatient post-surgical follow-up care -- to be covered by specified health insurers & health maintenance organizations.

FAWL supports "Female Inmate/Parent/Minor Children;" which provides legislative findings & intent re the importance of female inmates maintaining a relationship with her minor child; requires Dept. of Corrections to collect certain information concerning children of such inmates in state correctional system; requires DOC to analyze institutional assignment of each female inmate who is a parent & determine inmate's proximity to her minor child, etc. (SB 144)

FAWL Supports the "Prevention First Act;" requires Secretary of Health to develop & maintain certain information on family planning & health services on its website; requires Dept. of Education to develop comprehensive family life & sexuality education plan; provides duties of licensed health care facilities & practitioners regarding treatment of rape survivors.

FAWL supports legislation to ban female genital mutilation.
